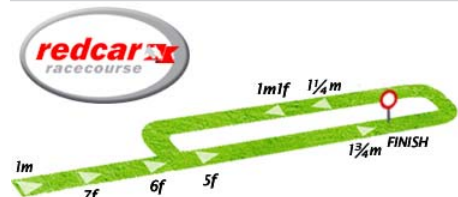

REDCAR TRACKFACTS



REDCAR is a narrow left-handed oval track, about 1m6f in extent. The round course is perfectly flat throughout, with very tight turns, and joins the straight just over 5f from the finish. The straight mile course is galloping in nature and middle to high-drawn runners have a decided advantage.
