
The Main Track played fairly though most riders stayed off the inside. No evidence the rail was bad. The turf courses played fairly.

While the Main Track played fairly overall, there were races that made the rail, particularly in the stretch, appear very strong. Saving ground for at least a significant portion of the race remains essentially a necessity to be successful on the Inner Turf.

Two of the three races on the Inner were won wire to wire but that appeared to be situational. Thursday, August 4 Fast / Firm Clear / Midday Showers 92 Wind 7 to 9 MPH NE A mild storm, that dropped less than 1/20th of an inch of rain, delayed the races for about 15 minutes before the 7th race. The Main Track was sealed during the rain, but was opened for the 8th race, the only dirt race among the final four races. While much of the best running was done at least a little off the inside on the dirt, there is no evidence the rail was bad. Perhaps worth following going forward. The turf courses played fairly both before and after the rain. Wednesday, August 3


