## Low Roller Handicapping Contest Rules

| Wagering Area: | Any Self Service Terminal |
| :--- | :--- |
| Entry Fee: | $\$ 30$ live money, $\$ 10$ Entry Fee (All Returned as prize money). |

## Contest Rules and Format

1. Contestants are only allowed to make, $\$ 2$, across the board bets ( $\$ 2 \mathrm{Win} /$ Place/Show on the same horse) through a selfservice terminal for a total cost of $\$ 6$.
2. Contestants may only select one horse per race.
3. Contestants must wager on five different races at NYRA's current live track.
4. Any contestant that wagers more than $\$ 30$ in the contest will be disqualified
5. Any contestant that wagers less than $\$ 30$ in the contest will have the difference from the amount they wagered and the $\$ 30$ required to be wagered removed from their final standings unless there is no Place or Show wagering available in the race.
6. Depositing money or withdrawing money from your account will result in disqualification.
7. Contestants may not withdraw funds until 30 minutes after the last race is official
8. In the event of a late scratch of a contestant's horse, the contestant is allowed to re-bet the race if time permits.
9. Odds are not capped.
10. The decision of the judges, NYRA Marketing and Special Events, in all matters or disputes relating to the tournament is final.
11. All official track rulings will apply to the horses selected for tournament play except as otherwise stipulated.
12. The contest concludes at the $2^{\text {nd }}$ to last race of the day.
13. If a contestant wins an IRS Withholding wager, their winnings will be shown on the leaderboard but they will not be able to bet any IRS withholdings. It's the player's responsibility to clear all IRS withholdings. NYRA is not responsible if a player misses a bet due to withheld winnings.
14. All bets must be placed with the contest card to count towards the tournament.
15. The entrant is solely responsible for ensuring that his or her wager is correct.
16. Contestants are fully responsible for placing their wagers, NYRA and tournament officials aren't responsible for any issue that may arise with a contestant placing their wager.
17. NYRA is not responsible for lost or stolen cards.

## Tournament Prize Structure

1. The total prize structure is based on the $\$ 10$ per player entry fee.
2. Order of finish is based on the highest accumulated earnings
3. If tie exists, prize money for that position will be equally divided among the contestants involved in the tie.
